

School Safety Questions Checklist

(Take this to your next PTA or school visit)

Ask your school these five questions:

1.	Staff Verification
	Have <i>all</i> teachers, bus drivers, attendants, and helpers undergone police verification and ID checks? Do you repeat this every year?
2.	Child Protection Committee
	Do you have a functional Child Protection/POCSO Committee? Who are the members (parents, teachers, external expert)? Is their contact information displayed on campus/website?
3.	Helplines & Awareness
	Where are child safety helpline numbers (like 1098) displayed? Do students know whom to call if they need help?
4.	CCTV & Campus Safety
	Are CCTVs installed in corridors, staircases, playgrounds, bus bays, and entry/exit points? Are they functional and monitored regularly?
5.	Student Safety Education
	Do children receive age-appropriate sessions on body safety, safe/unsafe touch, and online safety? How often are these conducted, and by whom?
	A school that answers these questions openly is likely taking safety seriously. A school that avoids or dismisses them may not be fulfilling its legal duty of care.

Remember: You're not being "that parent" by asking. You're being the parent every child deserves.
